

Chlamydia

Chlamydia is an STI and not a pretty present to give to your partner. It can spoil your health and mess up your chances of having children. Again you can have Chlamydia for years and not know about it. If Chlamydia's not treated in women, the infection can spread through the womb and fallopian tubes. Infection of the tubes can cause longer, heavier periods. It can also cause pain low down in the abdomen (belly) and even infertility. Chlamydia can also be passed on during childbirth from a woman to her baby, causing sticky eyes and possibly pneumonia. If it's not treated in men it can cause sore eyes, pain when passing urine (peeing) and sometimes pains in joints.
